THE CATALAN PRESENCE IN CANARY ISLAND MODERNISM

The main destinations of the trade routes from the Canary Islands to the Mainland around 1900 are Andalusia and Catalonia. As Madrid is a long way from a closer contact, Barcelona is left as the main trading, economic and cultural hub for the Islands. This route gives the Islands immediate access to and keeps them up-to-date on civilisation and progress. Canary Island university students study in Barcelona and they, in turn keep the islands informed about artistic tastes in Europe. This phenomenon not only brings products that keep the bourgeoisie on the cutting edge of architecture, encouraged by fierce demand, it also attracts experts and students from the School of Architecture to the two main islands. Hired in 1972 as a teaching assistant for practical classes, he combined this job with specialist studies in Italy, where he ended up as a resident at the Spanish Academy in Rome in 1987.

In July 1986, we won a tenured lectureship as a Lecturer in the History of Art at the University of La Laguna in a civil service examination and in September 2000, he was given a professorship, also in the History of Art, and also in a public civil service examination. He currently remains at the university as a professor in this subject.

He studied History of Art at the University of La Laguna. He was job as a teacher in the University of La Laguna (2010-2012), he combined this job with specialist studies in France and Belgium, where he ended up as a resident at the Centre André Chastel (INHA, Paris) and IRPA (Brussels).
