From Baroque to modernity of a Mexican city. Puebla between 1850 – 1950

**Abstract in English** of your presentation (maximum 1,000 characters)

The inclusion of the second most important city of the former viceroyalty of New Spain in the modern age can be studied from various perspectives. One of them is the modernization of the services and urban infrastructure, both which are related to the welfare of an upcoming bourgeoisie. Another perspective is the study of new aesthetic parameters associated with new ways of inhabiting the city houses. In this paper we intend to approach the relationship between city growth and the implementation of housing models inspired in European modernism, and how it developed alongside new comfort aspirations and the abandon of old ways of relating to the urban space. The documentary sources upon which this proposal is based on, come from the records of real estate projects and services localized in the local historical archive of the city of Puebla, and a private collection of 20 house facades.
