Title in English of your presentation

Women artists and political relationship. Four "female exhibitions" at Sala Parés in Barcelona (1896-1900)

Abstract in English of your presentation (maximum 1,000 characters)

In December 1896 an exhibition by Catalan women artists opened at Sala Parés, the best modern art gallery in Barcelona. It was the first of four (1897, 1899, 1900) at the same private gallery. The press of the time recognized the modernity of the event, but subsequent historiography did not. Our aim is to inscribe it in Catalan art history by analyzing it from four points of view. First, by itself, as an event showing artistic and social modernity, a concept that we will try to redefine. Secondly, in relation to the international context, especially Women's Pavilion of Chicago Exposition (1893) and the Union des Femmes Peintres et Sculpteurs of Paris. In both events painters who exhibited in Sala Parés had taken part. Third, we will explore the origins, on the hypothesis that besides Joan Baptista Parés the actual promoters for the initiative were some women artists who had been linked to the women's movement. Finally, we will discuss the particular nature of these exhibitions, artistic education as well as their professional carrier and body of work, whenever possible.

Laura Mercader: I'm teaching Art Theory and Modern Art in Art History Department of the Universitat de Barcelona (UB). I'm a researcher of Duoda, Research Center of Women at the same university (UB). I'm also the director of the journal "DUODA. Estudis de la diferència sexual". My main research interests are in Modernity and women artists, especially Catalan and Spanish ones, art criticism and feminist and postcolonial art theory, as well as feminism of sexual difference and women's movements.

Laura la Lueta: I graduated in Art History from Universitat de Barcelona (UB) in 2014 with a final thesis versed on the first exhibitions of female artists that took place in Barcelona at the end of 19th Century, tutored by Laura Mercader. I'm currently doing a postgraduate course on sexual difference at the same
