Muses, Women and Little Secrets at the Palau de la Música Catalana

The allegorical figures presiding the chamber of the *Palau de la Música Catalana* concert hall, the work of the architect Lluís Domènech i Montaner, are really some of the most beautiful allegorical examples of women in the Catalan *Modernista* movement.

The music and the evolution of the instruments, representing the ancient and classical world, the clear tradition through images of folklore or even of unique aspects of our history, are some of the things that these female figures show us. It is not difficult to understand why these pieces are commonly known as *muses,* women who have evoked the various arts since ancient times.

We would like to offer some of the secrets of this representation of femininity in which the stone contains the upper body which holds the instrument, as well as the lady's face and hands. The mosaic makes up the skirt, providing colour and patterns to her attire, one of the most unique combinations of femininity in the Catalan *Modernista* movement.
